



Granting Access to Your Healthcare Information Via MyKelseyOnline (Epic MyChart)

For you to fully utilize a third-party healthcare application, you will need to share your healthcare information with the application. Applications whose developers participate in Epic System's App Orchard will guide patients through the sharing process via Epic's MyChart.

The healthcare application will take you to your healthcare organization's MyChart portal where you will log in with your ID and password.



The title of the developer's application will be displayed along with additional information. Select Next to continue or Cancel to stop.



MyChart will provide key information regarding the developer and their application. Select Next to continue or Back to review the previous page.

About Health Tracker

- **What type of organization is offering the app?**
This app is provided by the developer who has agreed to follow HIPAA federal health privacy laws.
- **How is the app funded?**
This app is funded by the developer and grants by the NIH and NSF.
- **How is your data stored?**
This app stores data locally on your device.
- **Who will have access to your data when it is provided to the app?**
Other than you, people you authorize. You will specifically approve each time your information is accessed or shared.
- **Does this app tell you about the data it has collected about you?**
This app retrieves available health data from your healthcare organization so you can better track your care and conditions over time.
- **How will your data be retained?**
Your health data will only be retained on you device.
- **How will your data be used?**
Other than for your own use, this app may use data about you to improve its services in the future.




