MANAGE YOUR PRESCRIPTION BENEFITS ON THE GO

KelseyCare Advantage in partnership with our pharmacy benefit manager, CVS Caremark, provides useful services and online tools that will help you make the most of your Part D coverage.

Whether you need to find a pharmacy, check the KelseyCare Advantage drug list (formulary), review the status of your prescription mail order, or check your current or previous Explanation of Benefits (EOB), your CVS Caremark member portal has your Part D stored in one place for your convenience.

The member portal makes it easy to get organized with online EOBs from KelseyCare Advantage. Simply log in to your <u>Caremark.com</u> account to view up to 36 months of your EOBs (as of January 2021) organized by date and stored in one location. Opt-in to go paperless, and you will receive an email when your new statement is ready to view instead of receiving a paper copy in the mail. Going paperless cuts down on clutter and helps you keep your prescription information secure.

To get started, visit <u>Caremark.com</u> and choose to register for a new account. You will be required to enter your Member ID, which you can find on your Member ID card. Your ID will start with KCA followed by an 8-digit number. You can also contact the CVS Caremark Customer Care line at 1-888-970-0914 (TTY: 711) for assistance in registering for an account.

YOUR PLAN INCLUDES BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES

Kelsey-Seybold Clinic offers behavioral health services for KelseyCare Advantage plan members. Plan members can receive diagnostic testing, medication treatment, and counseling/therapy services with a therapist or psychologist.

A variety of care options are available including video evaluation using MyKelseyOnline, telephone consultations with a psychiatrist or physician assistant, in-office sessions.

- Your monthly plan premium will be *more* if you are required to pay a lifetime Part D late enrollment penalty for going without other drug coverage that is at least as good as Medicare drug coverage (also referred to as "creditable coverage") for 63 days or more.
- If you have a higher income, you may have to pay an additional amount each month directly to the government for your Medicare prescription drug coverage.

MINORITY MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

Racial and ethnic minorities often suffer from poor mental health outcomes due to cultural stigma, as well as a lack of access to mental health care services due to not having social or economic resources. The CDC and National Alliance on Mental Illness offer these tips:

- Learn healthy ways to cope with stress including avoiding negative news stories and limiting social media, taking care of your body, limiting alcohol, and avoiding illegal drugs or abusing prescription drugs.
- Seek help for any mental health issues you may be experiencing. As a KelseyCare Advantage member, there are a variety of resources available to you through your plan including accessing resources from Kelsey-Seybold Clinic or through Liveandworkwell.com. However, there are also a variety of free resources available at cdc.gov/ mentalhealth/tools-resources/index.htm if you have friends or family in need of help.
- **Find a provider** that you feel comfortable with, culturally. Don't be afraid to ask questions such as:
 - How do you see our cultural backgrounds affecting our communication and my treatment?
 - Is your treatment approach different when working with people from different cultures and if so, how?
- Finally, don't forget to check in with yourself to make sure you feel like you were treated with dignity and respect, as it's important for you to feel seen and heard in order for you to receive the best possible care.

NATIONAL IMMUNIZATION AWARENESS MONTH

Are you up to date on your COVID booster, flu shot, shingles shot and other immunizations? Make sure you are protected! Contact your Kelsey-Seybold doctor to see if your vaccines are current. There is no copay for many vaccines like COVID-19, pneumonia, flu, or Hepatitis B! Check your EOC for more information.

SUICIDE PREVENTION AWARENESS

As part of Suicide Prevention Awareness Month, National Suicide Prevention Week runs from September 10 (World Suicide Prevention Day) through September 16.

According to the Cleveland Clinic, as of fall 2022, adults over age 65 accounted for almost 17% of all suicides.

\$0 WELLNESS VISITS

Your plan covers preventive visits for a \$0 copay when you see a network doctor. Make sure you're up to date on routine exams such as your:

- Welcome to Medicare or Annual Wellness Visit
- Mammogram and Well Woman Exam
- Cardiovascular disease risk reduction visit
- Colorectal cancer screening
- Diabetes screening
- Immunizations such as: flu vaccine, pneumonia vaccine, COVID-19, Hepatitis B

STAY BALANCED

Falls are a major concern for older adults, but that doesn't have to be you! Reduce your risk of falls with these quick tips:

- Exercise to improve balance, flexibility, and coordination. Tai Chi and yoga are especially helpful with balance and flexibility. Silver Sneakers is a covered benefit with your plan. Find a fitness location near you at <u>SilverSneakers.com</u>
- Some medications may cause drowsiness or dizziness. If you think your medication may be causing issues, discuss your concerns with your doctor or pharmacist.
- Remove fall hazards in your home, make sure rooms are well lit, and remember to schedule your \$0 routine eye exam to make sure you see well.
- Whether indoors or outdoors, wear proper footwear that has non-slip soles and avoid high heels.
- Finally, be sure to drink enough water throughout the day, especially during hot humid months! Dehydration can make you dizzy and increase your chances of falling.

HbA1C Testing

Your HbA1C is a simple blood test used to measure your average blood sugar levels over the last 90 days. Knowing your HbA1C helps you and your doctor better manage your diabetes long term. Keeping your blood sugar under control helps prevent complications such as eye damage.

Retinal Eye Exam

Schedule your Retinal Eye Exam to protect your eyes against diabetic-related eye complications like diabetic retinopathy. Your plan includes a no cost eye exam each year to help detect and treat problems early.
